"By far the most interesting part of North Africa, then East Africa, was going up from Kenya through the N.F.D. into Ethiopia. Lots of "Shifita" trouble over their border dispute. Then the most of North Africa has "Shifita" trouble, but they go mostly for robbing.

"From Asseb, Eth., we took a ride on an Arabian Dhou to Aden and then went 600 miles into the hadhramout, South Arabia. Saw the skyscraper and mud city of Shibany. Was close to the Yemin border. It's about 120 degrees there in the shade — only no shade.

"The motorcycle still works good.

"The Africans give us a bit of a problem in that they don't want their photos taken, but you know Danny. He gets some pretty good shots anyway.
